

# DAVID SINKO STEUBER



Dave Steuber is the Executive Director of the Capital Region Development Authority (CRDA), a Connecticut quasi-public agency which invests in real estate and economic development projects in Hartford and its neighboring towns, and which also operates key regional facilities such as the Connecticut Convention Center, the Peoples Bank Arena, and Rentschler Field.

Steuber was previously the Chief of Staff & Director of Strategic Initiatives at the Connecticut Department of Economic & Community Development (DECD). He also served as Chief of Staff to Hartford Mayor Luke A. Bronin and earlier worked to cultivate the state's startup and innovation ecosystem at Connecticut Innovations / CTNext.

He spent over ten years as a policy analyst and aide at the Connecticut General Assembly, where his work concentrated on energy and fiscal policy. He helped to craft the so-called "fiscal guardrails" in 2017, which transformed the state's finances from deficits to record surpluses and have since reduced the state's unfunded pension liabilities by several billion dollars and counting.

Steuber holds a master's degree in business analytics from the University of Connecticut. A longtime Hartford resident raised in East Hartford and Ohio; he now lives in Wethersfield with his wife and young daughter.
